- That Local Government Re-Organisation is going ahead and NFDC was working with other local authorities on progressing the initial formation work for the various "shadow authorities".
- Due to the current extreme hot weather the waste collection teams were starting work much earlier and will probably do so for the next few weeks.

- With the support of Dist. Cllr. Joe Reilly attended the Councillor "Drop in Session" on July 9th.
- Is in process of updating the Parish Transport Leaflet (some voluntary services no longer run).
